Saying goodbye 道別	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Okay then, that's all for today. Goodbye. See you all tomorrow.</li> <li>• The bell has rung. It's time to finish.</li> <li>• Put your books away.</li> <li>• How much time do we have left?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We still have five minutes left.</li> <li>• That's all for today</li> <li>• Goodbye! See you tomorrow.</li> <li>• Have a nice weekend.</li> </ul>
