Everyone has experienced headaches, but only recently have medical researchers begun to learn more specifically about the causes and possible treatments for different types of headache pain.

The most common type of headache is the simple tension headache. Tension headaches are usually mild and short-lasting and can result from various factors, such as stress caused by worry or noise. Tension headaches are caused by a tightening of the neck or back muscles, which slows the flow of blood and, therefore, oxygen to the brain. It is lack of oxygen that causes the pain. Most headaches can be relieved by taking a *mild* analgesic such as aspirin. Analgesics expand the blood vessels and *restore* the normal flow of blood and oxygen to the brain.

A tiny minority of headaches can be linked to severe physical problems such as head injury or brain tumors. For these type of headaches, there are medicines to treat the symptoms, but there is no cure unless the underlying problems is removed.
